

The School Resource Officer (SRO) has three main functions:

1. **Safety** – The SRO works to ensure a safe learning environment for students, staff, and visitors. Duties also included investigating crimes within the school and making arrests when necessary.
2. **Education** – The SRO teaches classes upon request on a variety of topics. Main topics include drugs, alcohol, search and seizure, and criminal laws. He also leads the Law Enforcement Club, which meets after school once a month for forty-five minutes. The club is open to any interested students.
3. **Resource** – Lastly, the SRO is a law enforcement resource to the students, teachers, administration, parents, and the neighborhood surrounding the school. This individual can provide advice, help to resource police related issues, and answer questions about police procedure.
